The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Pabon, read in full and considered:

RESOLUTION # 3363-20

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PAYMENT OF HAZARD PAY FOR THOSE ESSENTIAL EMPLOYEES WORKING ON THE FRONT-LINE DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, during the COVID-19 pandemic many Housing Authority/PARTNER employees were required to work on site at all Dunlap RAD and Hansen RAD buildings; and

WHEREAS, those employees were considered to be essential by the Housing Authority administration and concurred by the Office of Emergency Management of the City of Perth Amboy as their presence was necessary to keep the residents safe and the buildings sanitized and secure; and

WHEREAS, the employees provided the following essential services:

- 1) Cleaned and sanitized the building daily
- 2) Maintained security to insure only residents and essential service providers were allowed to access buildings
- 3) Kept constant check on residents to make sure they were safe
- 4) Performed emergency work orders as needed to maintain safe and sanitary housing
- 5) Helped and assisted in COVID-19 testing for residents.
- 6) Helped coordinate food deliveries for those residents in need

And

WHEREAS, HUD in their Frequently Asked Questions dated 9/29/2020 allows for the payment of hazard pay with CARES Act funding so long as the amount of pay is reasonable and consistent with the industry; and

WHEREAS, these employees deemed to be essential and working on the front-line will receive a payment for hazard pay at the rate of 3% of their current salary. Payment will be included in the next payroll after the Board of Commissioners approves such payment. Payment will not become part of their base salary.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Perth Amboy the following:

- 1) Approval of a hazard pay payment to those employees deemed essential by the Authority administration and who worked on the front-line during the COVID-19 pandemic. Payment will be calculated at 3% of the employee's current rate of pay and will be made on the next payroll after adoption of this resolution.
- 2) Authorization for the Executive Director to advise the employees of such payment in a letter thanking them for their service during these most difficult times.
